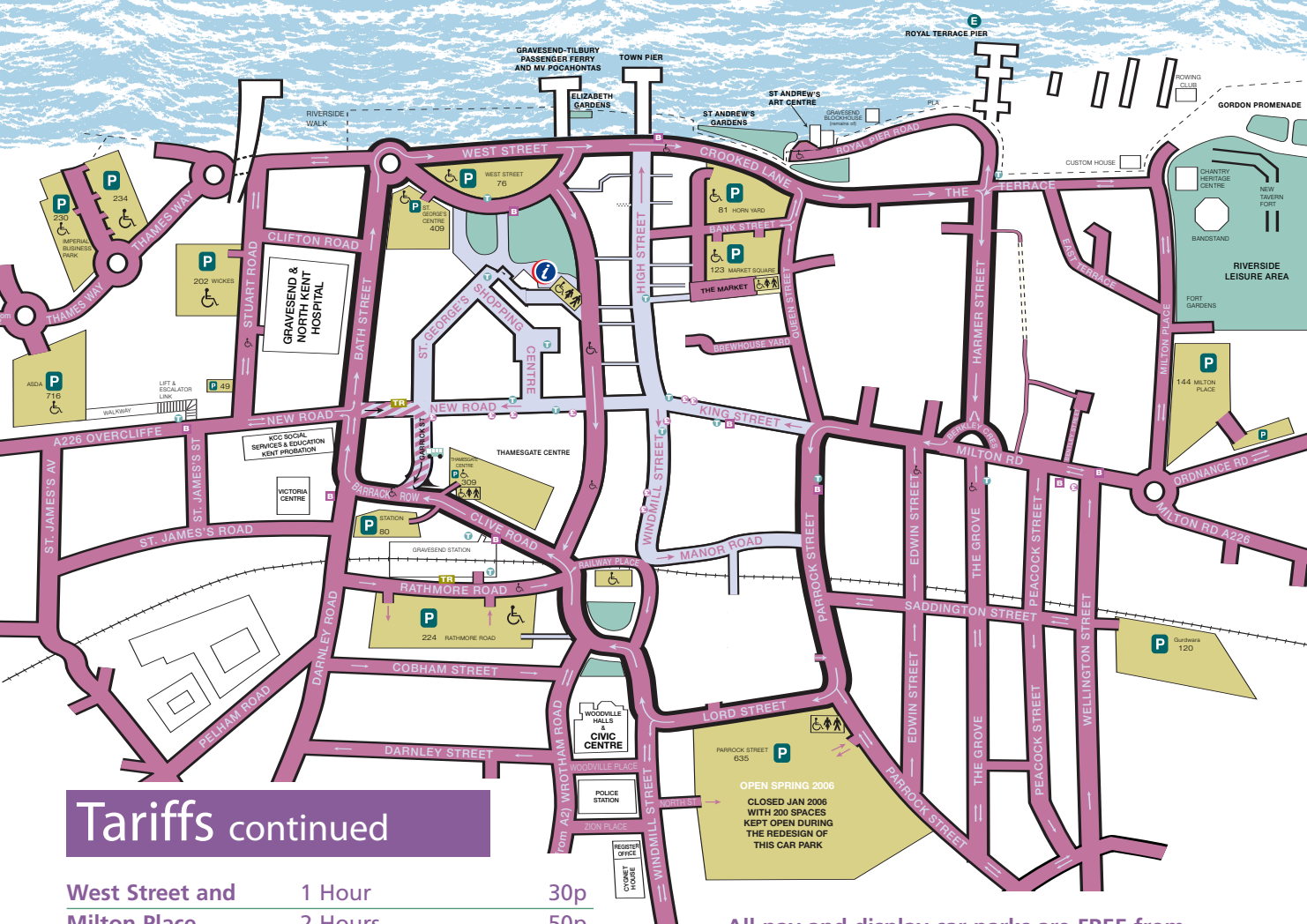

# Important information

**Lord Street multi storey car park will be taken permanently out of service from 14th October 2005. Parrock Street surface car park will close temporarily in January 2006 for up to six months for major improvement works although it is hoped to keep at least 200 spaces open at any one time.**

Whilst Parrock Street car park is partially closed from January 2006 we will be offering a temporary form of 'Park & Ride' scheme for commuters and people who work in Gravesend.

A hundred free car park spaces will be available at Cascades leisure centre in Thong Lane and a further hundred free spaces will be available at the Cygnet leisure centre on Hall Road. Patrons at Cascades can take the 499 bus from Cascades (£3.20 return). Patrons at Cygnets can take the 495 or 498 buses from Perry Street, near the junction with All Saints Road (£1.40 return).

The map on this brochure not only shows the Council run car parks but also the ones privately owned by the Railway station and the Thamesgate and St Georges Shopping centres.

If you are travelling up to London by train you may find it cheaper to park your car in Ordnance Road Pay and Display car park and walk the short distance to the Station. This car park has an all day charge of £1.50 with a maximum stay of 24 Hours.

On street pay and display will be brought in from October 2005 and is suitable for short term visits to the town.

Many of our car parks now have spaces for Blue Badge holders and these are free for 3 hours when parked in designated bays. They can be found in Rathmore Road, West Street, Horn Yard, Market Square and soon to be introduced into Milton Place and Parrock Street car parks.
